# **BEST PRACTICES: 2016-17**

# 1. Title: "Growing Within: Nurturing the potential of teachers and students'

**Objective:** To facilitate self-growth and actualization of potential of the teaching faculty and students through myriad ways of competence building.

#### **Context:**

Keeping in mind that quality assurance is a continuous process, and the need to facilitate the quality promotion, sustenance and enhancement among faculty and students and to develop a system for conscious, consistent and catalytic improvement and also to stimulate the academic environment for the attainment of an institution's academic objectives, the faculty and students of the college are provided ample opportunities. This in turn helps the process of fuelling back to the society and the community around the insights gained through participation in research based programmes.

#### **Practice:**

- The college organised International Conference on 4th Feb.2017, in association with Distance of Lifelong Learning and Extension (DLLE), University of Mumbai. The theme of the conference was "Emerging issues in Commerce, Management and Extension work". In all 86 research papers were presented in 4 sessions by the delegates. The proceedings of the conference were published with ISBN No. 9788193308370.
- The Department of History in association with Department of Rural Development of the college, in collaboration with Maharashtra Mahatma Gandhi Smarak NIdhi, Pune organised National Conference on 'Life and thoughts of Mahatma Gandhi-Relevance to 21st Century' 15th Feb.2017. In all 42 research papers were presented by researchers from various colleges and 13 research papers were presented by the students of the departments of History and Rural Development.
- The college organised a workshop on 'Self Defense for Girl Students' in association with the Department of Student's Development (DSD) of the University of Mumbai. The theme of the workshop was 'Self Defense' for the girl students from colleges in Palghar district. The Chief guest Assistant Police Inspector Rani Puri shared tips on how to avoid hostile situations and steps to be taken if confronted by such situations. Prof. Dr. Vibhuti Patel, Head of Department of Economics, SNDT University spoke on constitutional rights of woman and amendments in the law. Advocate Sadhana Dhuri and Adv. Prachi Collaco through interactive sessions focussed on educating girl students on avoidance, escape and in case of unexpected circumstances. Basic defense skills, tricks and techniques were learnt by the participants in the hands on training session demonstrated by Sensei Suryaprakash Mundapat and his team. Nearly 70 students benefitted from this exercise.

## **Obstacles Encountered and Strategies adopted:**

• To balance academic and extra-curricular activities in the semester mode -On the day of the conferences and workshop lecture timings were adjusted keeping in mind the schedule of the programme.

- The existing infrastructure needs to be enhanced and expanded to include state of the art equipment and an auditorium/ conference room.
- More finance needs to be mobilised through sponsorships.
