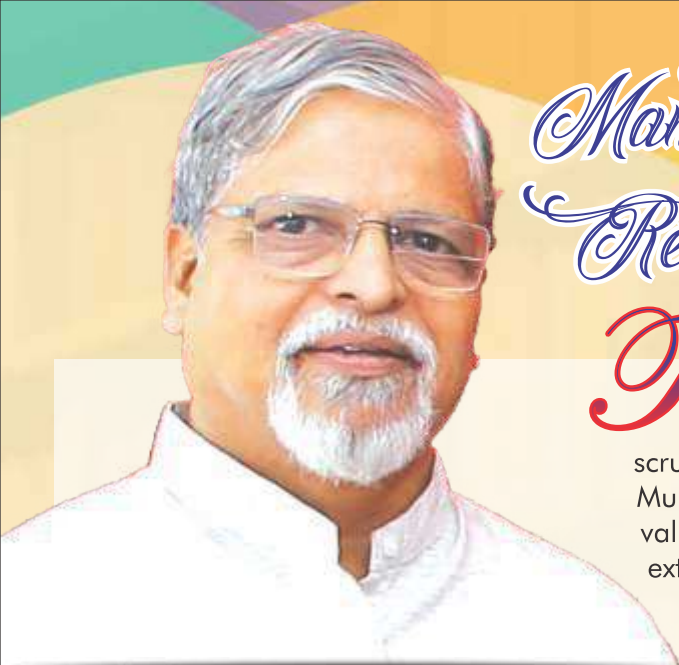

व्यस्त रहना काफी नहीं है, व्यस्त तो चीटियाँ भी रहती है। सवाल यह है कि, हम किसलिए व्यस्त है ?

दहेज एक अभिशाप

यूँ तो मानव समाज एवं सभ्यता के समक्ष कई सारी चुनौतियाँ मुँह बाँँ खड़ी हैं, परंतु इनमें से एक चुनौती ऐसी है, जिसका कोई भी तोड़ अभी तक नहीं दिख रहा है। कहना नहीं होगा कि विवाह संस्कार से जुड़ी हुई यह सामाजिक विकृति दहेज प्रथा ही है। दहेज कुप्रथा भारतीय समाज के लिए एक भयंकर अभिशाप की तरह है। “दहेज” शब्द अरबी भाषा के ‘जहेज’ शब्द से होकर उर्दू और हिंदी में आया है, जिसका अर्थ होता है ‘सौगात’। इस भेंट या सौगात की परम्परा भारत में कब से प्रचलित हुई, यह विकासवाद की खोज के साथ जुड़ा हुआ तथ्य है। कन्या के प्रति अपने स्नेह और वात्सल्य के प्रतीक के रूप में कुछ उपहार भेंट स्वरूप दिया करते थे। इन वस्तुओं के अतिरिक्त दैनिक जीवन में काम आनेवाली कुछ अन्य आवश्यक वस्तुएँ भी उपहार के रूप में दी जाती थी। उपहार की यह प्रथा कालिदास के काल में भी थी। कालांतर में स्वेच्छा से कन्या को प्रदत्त किया जानेवाला धन वरपक्ष का अधिकार बन गया और बाद में इस प्रथा ने एक कुप्रथा या बुराई का रूप धारण कर लिया।

दहेज प्रथा आज के मशीनी युग में एक दानव का रूप धारण कर चुकी है। यह ऐसा काला साँप है जिसका डसा पानी नहीं माँगता। इस प्रथा के कारण विवाह एक व्यापार बन गया है। यह दहेज प्रथा हिन्दू समाज के मस्तक पर एक कलंक है। इसने कितने ही घरों को बरबाद कर दिया है। अनेक कुमारियों को घुट-घुटकर मरने के लिए विवश कर दिया है। इसके कारण समाज में अनैतिकता को बढ़ावा मिला है। इस प्रथा के कारण समाज में बाल-विवाह जैसी अनेको कुरितियाँ ने जन्म ले लिया हैं।

दहेज की समस्या आजकल बड़ी तेजी से बढ़ती जा रही है। धन की लालसा बढ़ने के कारण वरपक्ष के लोग

विवाह में मिले दहेज से संतुष्ट नहीं होते हैं। परिणाम स्वरूप वधुओ को जिंदा जला कर मार दिया जाता है। इसके कारण बहुत से परिवार तो लड़की के जन्म को भी अभिशाप मानने लगे हैं। यह समस्या दिन-प्रतिदिन विकराल रूप धारण करती जा रही है। धीरे-धीरे सारा समाज इसकी चपेट में आता जा रहा है।

दहेज प्रथा को कैसे रोका जाए? तो इसका उत्तर होगा-कानून से। लेकिन लगता है कि आज कानून भी इसे रोक पाने में असमर्थ है। इसके लिए कन्या को शिक्षित और आर्थिक रूप में सम्पन्न होने पर अनमेल विवाह कम होंगे। घर की चारदिवारी से बाहर रहकर वह सास और ननदों के तानों से बची रहेगी। अच्छी आय हाथ से निकल जाने के भय से दूसरे लोग अनाप-शनाप बातें नहीं कर सकेंगे।

यह समस्या सही अर्थों में तभी समाप्त होगी जब युवक यह कहें कि हम बिना दहेज के ही विवाह करेंगे और कन्या यह सोचे कि वह दहेज लेने वालों से शादी नहीं करेगी। यदी दहेज की प्रथा खतम हो जाए तो भारत के स्त्री पुरुषों की छाती पर से एक बोझ उतर जाएगा। अतः हमें मिलकर इस प्रथा को जड़ से ही समाप्त कर देना चाहिए तभी हमारा समाज प्रगति कर सकता है।

It was my turn to take the shovel, but I felt too ashamed to dutifully send him off without saying a proper goodbye. I refused to throw dirt on him. It brought up almost every imaginable emotion inside me. The whole world can become an enemy when you lose what you love. It was like having a rug swept out from under me. I never thought about death myself until it was staring me in the face. I was told this was going to happen, but I never was prepared for it. In such a situation, you don't know what to say. You burn up, feeling dizzy but

no tears come. You have to get out of there, to escape, to run away, anything to make this fade. They didn't exactly say how long he had, but they thought it would be a month. But he proved them wrong. He lived for two ! The last words I said to him was that I was never going to find such a fierce and loyal friend like him. I wanted him to know. And then here comes the funeral. So many people are here because he was such an inspiration. Thousands of flowers in all shapes and sizes. It just proved how special he was to so many people. All the memories of our time together flash in front of my eyes. I knew no matter what I will never forget this man who was so important for me throughout my childhood. I sent up a silent prayer for him. And just like that I picked up the shovel again.
