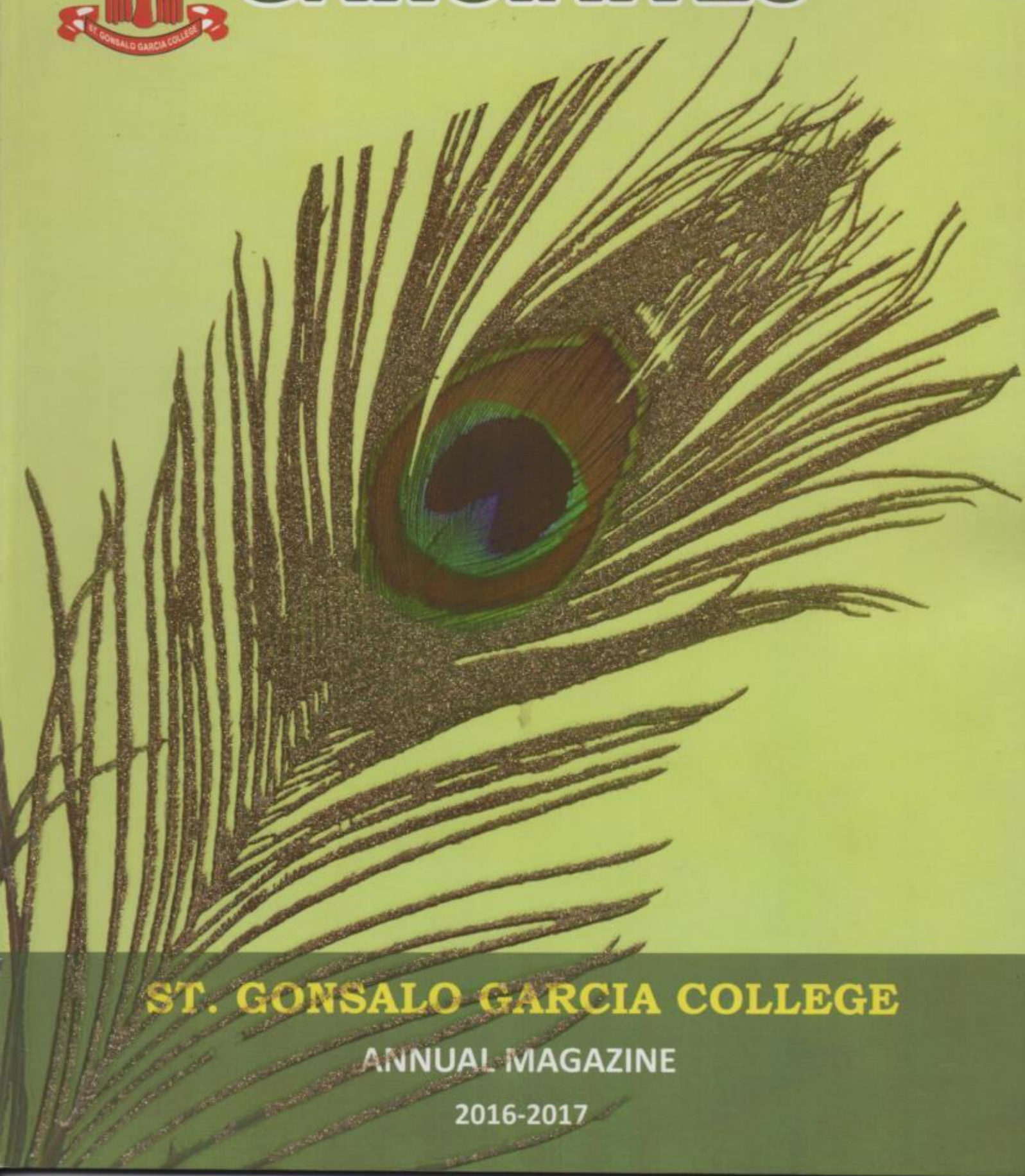

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साहित्यात मराठी मातीतील वास्तव मांडण्याचे भान व्यंकटेश माडगुळकर यांच्या 'बनगरवाडी' ने दिले पण त्या बरोबरीनेच द.मा.मिरासदार, शंकर पाटील यांच्यासारख्या दमदार साहित्यिकांनी त्यात भर घालायला सुरुवात केली आणि मराठी वाचकाला, ग्रामीण विश्वानेही भुरळ घातली. हे साहित्य काल्पनिक किंवा किस्सेवजा कथांतच कुंठत असताना पुढच्या पिढीने, त्यात नव्या संवेदनांची भर घालण्यास प्रारंभ केला. त्यामध्ये आनंद यादव यांचे नाव अटळपणे घ्यायला हवे. कोल्हापूरजवळील कागल गावाहून शहरात आलेल्या यादवांनी आपल्या मातीशी असलेली नाळ कधीच तुटू दिली नाही. 'गोतावळा' या त्यांच्या कादंबरीने साहित्यविश्वाचे लक्ष वेधून घेईपर्यंत त्यांनी कथा, कवितांचा आकृतिबंध हाताळलेला होता. एका मोठ्या पटावर आपली सकसता तपासण्याची संधी त्यांना गोतावळामुळे मिळाली आणि त्यानंतरच्या 'नटरंग', 'झोंबी', 'काचवेळ' यासारख्या त्यांच्या साहित्यकृतींनी मराठी वाचकाला काही नवे आणि दमदार वाचायला मिळाले. स्वातंत्र्यपूर्व काळातील ग्रामीण साहित्यापेक्षा यादवांच्या पिढीतील लेखन वेगळे होते, कारण त्यात वास्तवतेचे भान होते. ग्रामीण निसर्गवर्णनापेक्षा तेथील जगण्याला असलेली दुःखाची किनार आणि दाहकता लक्षात येण्यास बनगरवाडीतील व्यक्तिमत्त्वे समोर येत होती आणि नव्या लेखकांना एक नवी पायवाटही दाखवीत होती. उध्दव शेळके यांची 'धग' त्याच काळातील, रा.रं.बोराडे यांच्यासारख्या लेखकास 'सत्यकथा'च्या मांडवात जाऊन बसण्याचा मानही त्याच सुमारास मिळाला. हे सारे घडत होते, साठच्या दशकानंतर, या साहित्याची चिकित्सा करण्यास डॉ. भालचंद्र फडके यांनी सुरुवात केली आणि हे साहित्य समीक्षेच्याही परिघात येऊन ठेपले. तोपर्यंत साहित्यातील नैतिकतेलाही या ग्रामीण साहित्याने प्रश्नचिन्हांकित केले होते. स्वाभाविकच आनंद यादवांसारखे नव्या दमाचे लेखक भाषेच्या वेगळ्या वाटा-वळणे शोधू लागले. केवळ सत्य-कथनापलिकडे जाऊन त्यातील कलात्मक मूल्यांनाही जपण्याचे हे

भान त्यांच्यासारख्या साहित्यिकांनी दिले. 'ग्रामीण साहित्य: स्वरूप व समस्या' आणि 'मराठी साहित्य : समाज आणि संस्कृती' यासारख्या पुस्तकांच्या रूपाने समीक्षालेखनही केले. मध्यमवर्गीय संवेदनांच्या बाहेर जाऊन साहित्यात नंतर येऊ घातलेल्या दलित साहित्याला यादव यांच्यासारख्या लेखकांनी मार्ग दाखवण्याचे काम केले. ग्रामीण साहित्याची चळवळ सुरू करतानाही त्यांना शहरी पांढरपेशा वर्गाच्या विरोधाचा सामना करावा लागला. आयुष्याच्या उत्तरार्धात 'संतसूर्य तुकाराम' कादंबरीच्या निमित्ताने निर्माण झालेला वाद आणि साहित्य संमेलनाच्या अध्यक्षपदाचा राजीनामा इथपर्यंत त्यांचा संघर्ष सुरू राहिला. यादवांनी खेड्यातल्या माणसांचे दुःख, दैन्य, दारिद्र्य साहित्यातून वाचकांसमोर आणले. व्यंकटेश माडगुळकर, शंकर पाटील, द. मा. मिरासदार अशा आधीच्या पिढीतील दिग्गज ग्रामीण लेखकांचा प्रभाव ओलांडून स्वतःची वेगळी ओळख निर्माण केली. महात्मा जोतिराव फुले यांचे विचार हेच त्यांच्या ग्रामीण साहित्य चळवळीचे प्रेरणास्थान होते.

महाराष्ट्रातील आणि पर्यायाने भारतातील इतिहास लेखनाच्या कार्यपद्धतीतच मूलगामी बदल करणारे असे तीन थोर इतिहासकार म्हणजे इतिहासाचार्य वि.का. राजवाडे, दामोदर वर्मा कोसंबी आणि रामचंद्र चिंतामण ढेरे! डॉ. ढेरे यांनी कुठल्याही एका सैद्धांतिक दृष्टिकोनात अडकून न पडता इतिहास संशोधन कसे सर्वांगीण पद्धतीने करता येऊ शकते. त्याच वस्तुपाठ घालून दिला आहे. अगदी वैदिक परंपरेपासून सुरू करून सर्व प्रकारची स्थलपुराणे / स्थलमाहात्म्ये, देवतामाहात्म्ये, मिथकथा, मध्ययुगीन काव्ये, शिलालेख, ताम्रपट, मंदिरे-स्थळे, इतर पुरातत्वीय पुरावे, दंतकथा, अर्वाचीन उपासना परंपरा आणि याचबरोबर कधीही कुठेही ग्रंथित न झालेल्या लोक कलाकारांच्या मौखिक परंपरा, काव्ये, त्यांच्याकडच्या विविध दंतकथा / मिथके अशा सर्व प्रकारच्या पुराव्यांचे सटीक विश्लेषण करणे अत्यावश्यक आहे. हे प्रथम डॉ. ढेरे यांच्या इतिहास-लेखनातून दिसून आले. डॉ. ढेरे यांच्या अनेक पुस्तकांचे विषय आपल्या रोजच्या धर्मजीवनाशी, आपल्याला माहिती असलेल्या किंवा ऐकलेल्या लोकपरंपरांशी निगडित विठ्ठल, लज्जागौरी, खंडोबा, दत्तात्रेय, तुळजाभवानी, शिखर-शिंगणापूर, कोल्हापूरची महालक्ष्मी, नाथ संप्रदाय यांचे इतिहास लिहून डॉ. ढेरे यांनी पूर्ण महाराष्ट्राच्या गेल्या हजार वर्षांच्या सांस्कृतिक इतिहासालाच पालाण घातले आहे. जनसामान्यांना सहज आकलन होईल अशा सोप्या मराठीत त्यांचा ग्रंथप्रपंच केला. ज्या समाजाच्या परंपरांवर काम केले. त्या समाजातील सर्वांना कळेल अशा भाषेत लिहून त्यांच्यापर्यंत ते पोहोचवले. त्यांचे हे साहित्य आपण मनापासून वाचले, तरच ती या लोकतपस्वीला खरी श्रद्धांजली ठरेल.

डॉ. ए.पी.जे. अब्दुल कलाम का पूरा नाम डॉ. अब्दुल पाकिर जैनुलब्दीन अब्दुल कलाम । इनका जन्म १५ अक्टूबर, १९३१ को कोयंबटूर, तमिलनाडू में हुआ था। इनके पिता जैनुलब्दीन एक कम पढ़े-लिखे और गरीब नाविक थे। वह नियमों के पक्के और उदार व्यवहार के इंसान थे। वे अपनी नाव मछुआरों को देकर घर का गुजारा करते थे। परिणामस्वरूप बालक अब्दुल कलाम को अपनी आरंभिक शिक्षा पूरी करने के लिए घरों में अखबार वितरण करने का कार्य करना पड़ा। कलाम का छात्र जीवन बहुत कठिनाईयों में बीता। वह सुबह ४ बजे उठते और सबसे पहले गणित की ट्यूशन के लिए जाते, वहाँ से जाकर पिता के साथ कुरान शरीफ का अध्ययन करते और फिर अखबार बाँटने निकल पड़ते। बचपन में ही उन्होंने यह निश्चय कर लिया था कि उनका लक्ष्य विज्ञान और तकनीक के क्षेत्र में उन्नति करना है, जिस कारण उन्होंने कॉलेज में भौतिक विज्ञान विषय को चुना। इसके बाद उन्होंने मद्रास इंस्टीट्यूट ऑफ टेक्नॉलॉजी से एलेक्ट्रिकल इंजिनियरिंग की पढ़ाई पूरी की।

जोड़ो भारत

सन् १९६२ में कलाम भारतीय अंतरिक्ष अनुसंधान संगठन से जुड़ गए। इसके बाद उन्होंने अपनी सफलता की कहानी गढ़नी शुरू कर दी। प्रोजेक्ट डायरेक्टर के रूप में भारत का पहला स्वदेशी उपग्रह प्रक्षेपात्र बनाने का श्रेय उन्हें हासिल है। डॉ. ए.पी.जे. अब्दुल कलाम जुलाई १९९२ से दिसम्बर १९९९ तक रक्षा मंत्री के विज्ञान सलाहकार तथा सुरक्षा शोध और विकास विभाग के सचिव रहे। वे भारत सरकार के मुख्य वैज्ञानिक सलाहकार भी रहे। १८ जुलाई २००२ को डॉक्टर कलाम को नब्बे प्रतिशत बहुमत द्वारा भारत का राष्ट्रपति चुना गया था।

डॉ. अब्दुल कलाम की सहायता से भारत ने परमाणु हथियार के निर्माण की क्षमता प्राप्त करने में सफलता अर्जित की। उन्हें विज्ञान के क्षेत्र में अपने उत्कृष्ट योगदान के लिए भारत नागरिक सम्मान के रूप में १९८१ में 'पद्मभूषण', १९९० में 'पद्मविभूषण' और सन् १९९७ में 'भारतरत्न' यह सर्वोच्च सम्मान दिया गया। डॉ. सर्वपल्ली राधाकृष्णन और डॉक्टर जाकिर हुसैन के बाद यह एकमात्र ऐसे राष्ट्रपति हैं जिन्हें 'भारतरत्न' का सम्मान राष्ट्रपती बनने से पूर्व ही प्राप्त हुआ था।

भारत के इस महान सपूत का ८३ वर्ष की अवस्था में २७ जुलाई, २०१५ को निधन हुआ।

WRITERS AND THEIR WORLD

The written word has the power to generate ideas, inspire revolutions and change the way we view ourselves. Nowhere is this power more clear than in the works of writers. There are many writers who have left a permanent mark of their influence on the world.

One of the most cherished authors ever lived is William Faulkner. He was born in the United States. He churned out a body of work in the early 20th century that took a few years to find acceptance among a wider audience. Between 1929 and 1936, he released four novels- 'The Sound and the Fury', 'As I lay dying', 'Light in August' and 'Absalom ! Absalom !' These novels defined his stream of consciousness, style and his explorations of morality using characters set in his native Mississippi. He also wrote screenplays for director Howard Hawks, contributing to 'The Big Sleep' and 'To have and Have not'. But it was his literary body that earned him the Nobel Prize in 1949, which brought him a new level of fame. He has influenced countless writers from the South and across the country.

Another morally immortal writer is Franz Kafka. Not many writers make such an impact that their name becomes an adjective that describes works reminiscent of their own style.

Whenever a story takes a surreal turn that highlights the unconquerable complexity of a faceless system is called 'Kafkaesque'. 'The Trial' is a harrowing novel about a man persecuted by an omniscient authority for a crime whose nature is never revealed. 'The Metamorphosis' is a similarly disturbing book in which the narrator awakens to learn he's turned into a giant bug.

As I said; surreal. Harriet Stowe is a figure who railed against slavery. She is best known for her novel 'Uncle Tom's Cabin', published in 1852. The book revolves around the lives of slaves in realistic ways and helped make the issues of inequality understandable and accessible to millions of Americans. It was the best selling novel of the 19th century. While Stowe intended the title character of Uncle Tom to be a noble, Christian slave; various 'Tom Shows' that took advantage of weak copyright laws sprung up. Those plays often differed drastically from Stowe's novel. Still, there is no denying Stowe's widescale impact.

These writers have had a large impact on the minds of the masses worldwide.

MY FAVOURITE WRITER

RABINDRANATH TAGORE

Rabindranath Tagore was born in 1861 in Calcutta into the wealthy and cultured Tagore family of Jorasanko. His grandfather called 'Prince' Dwarkanath for his splendour and his munificence - was a prosperous man of business and a keen enthusiast about the social reforms initiated by Raja Rammohan Roy. The father, Debendranath, popularly known as Maharshi or the Great saint was a leading figure in the unitarian Brahmo Samaj or Sabha founded by Rammohan.

Rabindranath himself says that he was born at a time when the country was stirred by three movements. The first, which was religious, carried on a ceaseless war against superstitions. The second was literary. Under Bankim chandra it helped to free Bengali language and literature from the rigidity of effete rules and forms. The third movement, coming in the wake of the sepoy upheaval, was largely political. It meant the awakening of the nationalist sentiment, which later on received powerful support from Rabindranath, and culminated, after decades of striving and struggle, in the attainment of independence, which however, the poet did not live to see. A poet is born, not made, but, it will be convenient to consider Tagore's achievements under the three points of view outlined above.

A prolific author, Rabindranath started writing verse even in his teens. Very soon he became the leading poet in Bengali and his songs were sung all over the province. His output was large, and his

lyrics produced a deep impression by their sweetness and force. He did not ferred on him some years previously. The passionate letter he wrote on this occassion is one of the nobles documents of Indian nationalism.

It was he who gave to M.K.Gandhi the appellation 'Mahatma' a title by which he came to be known all over the world. Mahatmaji called him The Great Sentinel, an appropriate description of the poet and prophet who kept a vigilant watch over the loftiest ideals of humanity.

Although primarily a poet, Tagore had many-sided talents. He established what has come to be known as the Tagore School of music; his paintings, although not so famous as his songs, evoked wide interest, and he may be said to be the inventor of a new genre- the dance drama. He was also an experimenter in the field of education.

As far back as 1901 he established a novel school at Shantiniketan, where children would learn their lessons in the open air in intimate contact with nature, and education would mean not merely the sharpening of the intellect or an exercise of the memory but also an awakening of the creative impulse. After 1913 he became a world figure and was increasingly convinced- even in the midst of Gandhiji's Non-co-operation movement of the necessity for co-operation between different peoples and cultures of the world.

A talk on GST a step towards Indirect-tax reforms in India

Mr. Jaideep Barve C.A., A professor and a practicing Chartered Accountant brought the subject live before the faculty and students. He explained to the participants how this indirect taxation merges most of the existing taxes into a single system of taxation. GST would be a comprehensive indirect tax on manufacture, sale and consumption of goods and services throughout India to replace taxes levied by the central and state governments system of indirect taxation merging most of the existing taxation in

India into a single system of taxation. He emphasized the need of commerce students acquainting with the new system and its implications. The lecture benefitted the students and faculty to develop an overall view on GST.

A Lecture on "Export marketing as a Career"
