THE MANAGER'S INSIGHTS...





Being a die hard nature lover, looking out for a place to settle with her newly started family brought her to the plush, green belt of Vasai and St. Gonsalo Garcia College in 1987 which was then under the leadership of Fr. Rumao and later Fr. Velingkar.

My association with Prof. Rooma began the moment I joined college. She being the Programme Officer of N.S.S. at that time, with her band of volunteers involved me in their activities and projects, of which the most memorable ones are the Helpage India Project, Latur Eqrthquake Relief Mission. She was a mentor guide, motivator, counsellor to students having faith in their abilities to do their best.

The time I spent with her preparing yearly reports of IQAC revealed her deep insight



VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN

Although the history of violence against women is difficult to track, it is clear that much of the violence was overlooked and even legally sanctioned in earlier times. Examples include that Roman Law gave men the right to chastise their wives, even to the point of death, the burning of witches was condoned by the Church. Certain religions are no longer associated with a specific form of violence. But such violence was common back in the 19th century.

Violence hampers women's contribution towards society. Many women are terrified by these threats of violence and this terribly influences their lives. They fear contributing to the development of their communities socially, economically or politically due to fear of being exploited. Many times, this violence leads to severe health issues among the affected women. They are likely to be victimized by someone whom they are in close proximity to. The custom of dowry is a huge cause of violence in India. It is

important to strive towards creation of a peaceful social climate with no tolerance for gender based violence.

It is necessary to provide women with effective protection by which they can avoid becoming easy targets for pervert men.

एक किसान की आत्मकथा

मैं भारत देश का एक किसान हूँ। बिहार के गोपालगंज जिले के तुलवाँ नामक गाँव में पैदा हुआ ।पढ़ाई के उस दौर में एक बात सुनी-सीखी कि कमल पैदा तो कीचड़ में होता है। इतना सुन्दर और अद्वितीय होता है कि उसे राष्ट्रीय पुष्प का दर्जा प्राप्त है। मैं जी-तोड़ मेहनत करता था। गर्मी के मौसम में चोटी का पसीना एड़ी से होता हुआ खेत में पहुँचता तो एक ही खयाल आता कि शायद यहीं होती है खून-पसीने की कमाई । यह पाँचवी कक्षा में पढ़ा था। लेकिन ये तो सिर्फ पसीने की ही कमाई हुई, खून की कमाई क्या होती है ? यह प्रश्न बार-बार मन में आता था। खैर, वह भी कभी समझ में आ जायेगा, इतना सोचकर चिलचिलाती धूप में भूसे का गट्ठर सिर पर रखकर घर आ जाता। रूखी-सुखी रोटी खाकर ठंडा पानी पीता और थोड़ी देर आराम करके फिर वहीं खेतों में पहुँच जाता। सोचता था कि मैं देश का बहुत ही महत्त्वपूर्ण व्यक्ति हूँ, जो पूरे देश के लिए अनाज के साथ-साथ और जरूरी चीजें भी पैदा करता हूँ। लहलहाती फसलों को देखकर मेरा सीना गर्व से चौड़ा हो जाता था । लगता था कि राष्ट्रीय स्तर पर मेरा भी सम्मान होगा ।

फिर एक दिन मैंने सुना कि गाँव के पास एक चौड़ी सड़क बन रही है, और सरकार गाँव के खेतों पर कब्जा कर रही है। यह सुनकर मुझे जबरदस्त धक्का लगा। फिर अचानक मन में खयाल आया ऐसा कैसे हो सकता है? मैं इस देश का सबसे महत्त्वपूर्ण व्यक्ति ही नहीं अंग भी हूँ। यह सब अफवाह है। परंतु कुछ दिन बाद मेरा विश्वास टूट गया। जैसे ही मैं खेतमें पहुँचा, बड़ी-बड़ी दैत्याकार मशीनें मेरी प्यारी उपजाऊ मिट्टी, जिसपर कभी मैं अपने बैलों की घण्टियों की रुनझुन आवाज सुना करता था, उसको बेरहमी उठाकर फेंक रही थी। मेरे होठ काँपने लगे और आँखे डबडबा गयीं। अँगोछे को मुँह पर रखकर फफकी रोके हुए मैं घर पहुँचा और बिलख-बिलख कर रो पडा। ये हाल सिर्फ मेरा ही नहीं बल्कि मेरे जैसे हर एक किसान का था। अगले दिन गाँव की चौपाल पर बैठक हुई जिसमें तय हुआ कि सरकार के पास चलकर मुआवजा माँगेंगे। आँखों में मुआवजे की आस लिए किसानों के समूह में मैं भी था। सरकारी दफ्तर पहुँचे तो किसी ने सीधे मुँह बा तक नही की, दु:ख-दर्द पूछना तो दूर की बात थीं। कुछ किसान उत्तेजित हो गये और नारेबाजी पर उत्तर आयें, लेकिन कीचड़ में पैदा हुए किसान की औकात कीचड़ के कीड़े से ज्यादा कुछ नहीं आँकी गयी । दफ्तर की सुरक्षा के लिए खड़े खाकी वर्दी पहने वे सिपाही जो आमतौर पर अपनी सुस्ती और लापरवाही के लिए जाने जाते हैं, हमारे ऊपर काल बनकर टूट पड़े। धांय-धांय की आवाज से भगदड़ मच गई। एक-एक करके तीन गोलियाँ मेरे सीने में आ धँसी. और उज्ज्वल भविष्य के सपने के साथ मेरी आँखे बन्द हो गयी। मेरी मौत के बाद भी मामला यहीं खत्म नहीं हुआ और सफेद पोशाकें पहने लोगों का हुजुम मेरे मृत शरीर के पास आकर 'सरकार मुर्दाबाद' तथा 'किसानों का खून बेकार नही जायेगा' जैसे नारे लगाने लगा। वही पास में भटक रहीं मेरी आत्मा को समझ में आया कि शायद यही है मेरे खून की कमाई और साथ-साथ यह भी समझ में आ गया कि मेरे 'खून-पसीने' की कमाई मेरे लिए नहीं बल्कि उन्ही के लिए है जो नारेबाजी कर मेरी मौत पर राजनीति का मजा लूट रहे हैं। तो ये थी मेरी कथा। मुझ गरीब किसान की आत्मकथा को आपने अपना कीमती वक्त निकालकर सुना इसलिए मैं आप सबका, मन की गहराई से धन्यवाद अदा करता हैं।

DEPT. OF COMMERCE & ACCOUNTS
