ग्रंथ हेच गुरु



“गुरुरब्रम्हा, गुरुरविष्णु, गुरुरदेवो, महेश्वरः”, अशी गुरुची महती आहे. गुरुशिवाय कुठलेही ज्ञान प्राप्त होत नाही. आपल्या सर्वांच्याच जीवनामध्ये गुरुंचे स्थान खूप महत्त्वाचे आहे. चांगल्या संस्कारासाठी आपल्याला गुरुंच्या मार्गदर्शनाची गरज असते. म्हणूनच संत कवींनी म्हटले आहे की ‘गुरुविना कौन बतावे वाट, बडा बिकट है यम घाट.’

असे म्हणतात की मनुष्य लहानपणापासून ते म्हातारपणापर्यंत शिकतच असतो. ह्या काळात जे-जे त्याला ज्ञान देणारे असतील ती व्यक्ती त्याची गुरुच असते. आता प्रत्येक वेळी ज्ञान देणारे मानवी गुरुच असतील असे नाही. वेगळ्या अर्थाने ज्ञान देणारे गुरु म्हणजे ग्रंथ

कोणतेही ज्ञान आपण ग्रंथामधून मिळवू शकतो. मात्र ग्रंथाची निवड करणे महत्त्वाचे आहे. ग्रंथरूपी गुरुच्या आधारे आपण अगदी आध्यात्म ज्ञानापासून तर नीती व व्यावहारिक ज्ञान प्राप्त करू शकतो.

ग्रंथामधून भुतकाळातील गोष्टी अनुभवू शकतो. तर वर्तमान भविष्यकाळाची स्वप्ने आपण ग्रंथामधून पाहू शकतो. व्यक्ती, समाज आणि राष्ट्राच्या उभारणीत ग्रंथांचे योगदान महत्त्वाचे असते आपल्या गुरुकडून आपल्याला खूप गोष्टी शिकायला मिळतात. त्याचप्रमाणे ग्रंथ हे आपले जिवलग मित्र आहेत, गुरु आहेत, फक्त आपण त्या ग्रंथातील ज्ञान मिळवण्यासाठी वाचन केले पाहिजे. आपल्या जीवनाला दिशा देण्याचे काम ग्रंथ करत असतात. आपल्या संस्कृतीचे खरे वारसदार ग्रंथ आहेत.

ग्रंथ आपल्याला चांगल्या आणि वाईटाची जाणीव करून देत योग्य मार्गावर चालण्यास शिकवतात. ज्ञानेश्वरी, दासबोध, तुकारामाची गाथा, असे विविध ग्रंथ आपल्याला मार्गदर्शक ठरतात. ग्रंथ हे आपल्याला भरपूर ज्ञान देतात. ग्रंथ हा असा खजिना आहे त्याचा उपयोग करून आपण समृद्ध होत जातो. ग्रंथ आपल्याला जीवनाचा अर्थ सांगायला मदत करतात. ग्रंथ आपल्याला खूप काही शिकवतात. ग्रंथाच्या वाचनातून आपल्याला वेगवेगळी माहिती मिळते. अनेक महान लोकांनी ग्रंथाचे महत्त्व सांगितले आहे. वाचनामुळे आपण सुसंस्कृत होतो. वेगवेगळ्या विषयांवरील ग्रंथ एकत्रित पाहिले तर ग्रंथांचे स्वतंत्र व वेगळे विश्व आपल्यासमोर उभे राहते. ग्रंथांमध्ये लिहिलेले ज्ञान हे आपल्याला कधीही उपयोगी पडू शकते.

मराठी भाषेचा इतिहास सांगायचा झाला तर मराठी भाषेतील पहिला शिलालेख कर्नाटक मध्ये श्रवणबेळगोळ येथील गोमेटश्वराच्या मूर्ती खाली आढळलेला आहे. मराठी भाषेचा उगम हा प्राकृत भाषेच्या महाराष्ट्री या बोलीपासून झाला असे बहुतांशी मानले जाते.

१३ व्या शतकातील महान वारकरी संत ज्ञानेश्वर यांनी भगवतगीतेवर मराठीत ज्ञानेश्वरी ग्रंथ लिहिला. संत तुकाराम यांनी सुमारे ३००० अंभंग लिहिले. ज्ञानेश्वरी, पसायदान, मनाचे श्लोक शिवाय अनेक लेखकांनी लिहून ठेवलेले लेख, कवींच्या कविता हे मराठी साहित्यकारांनी दिलेले अमुल्य ज्ञान आज मराठीच्या रुपात जिवंत आहे. आजपर्यंत आपल्याला जेवढे लेखक, साहित्यकार लाभलेले आहेत त्यांनी मराठी भाषेचे महत्त्व जपून ठेवलेले आहे. महाराष्ट्राची मातृभाषा एक असली तरीही, मराठी बोली दर बारा कोसावर बदलते असे म्हटले जाते. प्रत्येक भागात राहणाऱ्या लोकांची निरनिराळी बोली आहे. उदा. कोंकणी, अहिराणी, वऱ्हाडी या प्रमुख बोलीभाषा आहेत.

संतांनी लिहिलेले ग्रंथ, अनेक विचारवंत आणि लेखकांनी लिहिलेली पुस्तके, कथा, कादंबऱ्या, काव्यसंग्रह यामुळे मराठी भाषेचे महत्त्व वृद्धीगत झाले आहे.. आपल्या विचारांची, परंपरांची, संस्कृतीची देवाणघेवाण ही भाषेतूनच होते. ग्रामीण भागात बोलली जाणारी मराठी भाषा जी बोलीभाषेत आहे त्यातील गोडवा मनाला सुखावून जातो. त्यामुळे बोली आणि भाषेतून व्यक्तीमन जवळ येते व सामाजिक, सांस्कृतिक कार्याची देवाण घेवाण करते.

मोबाईल फोन बातचीत या संदेश भेजने हेतु प्रयुक्त एक इलेक्ट्रॉनिक उपकरण चलभाषा: सचल दूरभाषा यंत्र । मोबाईल का फुल फॉर्म मॉडिफाइ ऑपरेशन बाइट इंटीग्रेशन लिमिटेड एनर्जी होती है । वर्तमान युग में मोबाईल फोन हमारे जीवन मे एक अहम हिस्सा बन गया है । आज हर व्यक्ति के पास मोबाईल फोन है , चाहे गरिब हो या अमीर हो । विज्ञान के कई आविष्कारों में से मोबाईल एक अनोखा आविष्कार है ।

इससे विद्यार्थियों के पढ़ाई पर असर पड़ता है। उनका पढ़ाई से मन उब जाता है। जब भी उन्हें मौका मिलता है, तो वो मोबाइल के नोटिफिकेशन चेक करते हैं। आये दिन मोबाइल फोन के नए मॉडल बाजार में आने की वजह से वह नया मोबाइल लेते हैं। इससे बेफिजूल खर्चा होता है। इससे पढ़ाई पर बुरा असर पड़ता है। मोबाइल के अत्याधिक उपयोग से व्यक्ति परिवार के साथ कम वक्त बिताता है। जब भी व्यक्ति को खाली समय मिलता है तो बस मोबाइल फोन चैट गाना सुनना इत्यादि में लग जाता है। वह सोशल मीडिया की दुनिया में खो जाता है और परिवार के संग कम समय

मतदान हमारा अधिकार हैं



मतदान न केवल हमारा अधिकार है बल्कि हमारा कर्तव्य भी है। यह वाक्य हमें स्पष्ट रूप से बताता है की हमें वोट अवश्य डालना चाहिए। बहुत बार लोग यह सोचते है की एक वोट से बहुत फर्क नहीं पडेगा, लेकिन यह सच्चाई से बहुत दूर है। लोगों को इसे समझना चाहिए।

२६ जनवरी १९५०को भारत का संविधान लागू किया गया था, जिसमें यह लिखा गया था कि अब से भारत एक लोक तांत्रिक देश है। हम सभी जानते हैं कि लोकतांत्रिक देश में सभी नागरिक को वोट देने का अधिकार होता है। परंतु कुछ नागरिक ऐसे होते है, जो अपना वोट कीमती नहीं समझते हैं और मतदान के समय वोट नहीं करते है। ऐसे लोगों को यह जानना बहुत ही अधिक जरुरी है कि एक वोट भी कितना किमती हो सकता है। उदाहरण के तौर पर फ्रांस एक देश है, जहाँ नागरिक अपनी जिम्मेदारी समझता है कि उसको मतदान देना चाहिए। इसीलिए वह एक लोकतांत्रिक देश का सबसे बड़ा उदाहरण है। हमारे भारत में सबसे बड़ा उदाहरण वोट न देने का यह देखा गया, जब अटल बिहारी वाजपेयी की सरकार बनी थी। तब सिर्फ एक वोट से सरकार गिर गयी थी। मतदान केवल सरकार के लिए ही नहीं होता है बल्कि आम नागरिक के लिए भी बहुत ज्यादा जरुरी होता है। हमारे भारत देश में ५ वर्ष में एक बार चुनाव किया जाता है। कई लोग इसको बेकार समझते हैं। इसके चलते सरकार को हर बार मतदान जागरुकता अभियान चलना पड़ता है। कई जगह रैली निकाली जाती है और मतदान का प्रचार किया जाता है।

चुनाव शब्द दो शब्दों से मिलकर बना है, चुन और नाव जिसका अर्थ होता है योग्य व्यक्ति का चयन करना। वैसे तो चुनाव का इतिहास काफी पुराना है लेकिन वर्तमान समय में यह मानव विकास का एक अहम हिस्सा है। चुनाव किसी भी लोकतंत्र का आधार स्तंभ माना जाता है। किसी भी स्वस्थ लोकतंत्र के लिए एक निश्चित अंतराल के बाद चुनाव प्रक्रिया का होना काफी आवश्यक होता है, क्योंकि ऐसा ना होने पर वर्तमान राजनेताओं और देश की बागडोरे सँभालने वाले व्यक्तियों में ऐसी भावना उत्पन्न हो जाती है कि उन्हे पद से कोई नहीं हटा सकता है। एक देश के विकास के लिए चुनाव बहुत अहम प्रक्रिया है क्योंकि यह देश के राजनेताओं में इस बात का भय पैदा करता है कि यदि वह जनता का दमन या शोषण करेंगे तो चुनाव के समय जनता अपनी वोटों के ताकत द्वारा उन्हें सत्ता से बाहर कर सकती है।

२५ जनवरी, २०११ को पहली बार राष्ट्रीय मतदाता दिवस मनाया गया था। इन दिन को मनाने का मकसद न केवल चुनाव आयोग द्वारा जनता को वोट डालने के लिए प्रोत्साहित करना है, बल्कि वह १८ साल के युवाओं को वोटर आईडी कार्ड सौंपकर देश के युवा मतदाताओं को चुनावी प्रक्रिया में भागीदारी लेने और इसकी अहमियत को भी बताता है।



लोकतंत्र जनता की, जनता के द्वारा जनता के लिए सरकार है, अब्राहम लिंकन के इस विचार और लोकतंत्र के दर्शन को मतदान के माध्यम से ही वास्तविकता में बदला जा सकता है। यानी देखा जाए तो मतदान एक बुनियादी प्रक्रिया है जो एक लोक तांत्रिक देश की सरकारी प्रणाली का निर्माण करती है। मतदान का अधिकार देश के नागरिकों को सरकार में अपने प्रतिनिधी चुनने की अनुमति देकर उन्हें सशक्तता प्रदान करता है। मतदान करके नागरिक परिवर्तन और विकास की दिशा तय कर सकते हैं। मतदान ही वह जरिया है जिसका उपयोग कर नागरीक अपने देश, स्थानिय निर्वाचन क्षेत्र या किसी उम्मीदवार के बारे में मतपेटी के माध्यम से परिवर्तन कर सकते हैं। वर्ष २००० के बाद चुनाव सुधार:- जागरुकता के मद्देनजर सरकार द्वारा २५ जनवरी को राष्ट्रीय मतदाता दिवस के रूप में घोषित किया गया। पोस्टल बैलेट के माध्यम से मतदान की सुविधा की शुरुवात जिसमें मतदाताओं का एक सिमित समुह डाक मतदान का प्रयोग कर सकता है। इस सुविधा के माध्यम से एक मतदाता मतपत्र पर अपनी वरीयता दर्ज करके अपना वोट दे सकता है। चुनाव में धन की बढ़ती भूमिका हमारी चुनाव व्यवस्था का गंभीर दोष बनती जा रही है, हाँलाकी, Conduct of Election (Amendment) Rule, 2020 के जरिए Conduct of Election Rules, १९६१ अनुच्छेद १० में अ संशोधन कर चुनावों में खर्च की सीमा को बढ़ा दिया गया है, किंतु फिर भी इसमें अधिक धन का इस्तेमाल एक प्रमुख मुद्दा बना हुआ है। एक तरफ जीत आधारीत राजनिति, राजनिति का अपराधी करण आदी देश की एकता पर प्रहार कर रहे है, तो वहीं दूसरी ओर वोटों को खरीद फरोख्त भी देश के लोकतंत्रिक ढाँचे को कमजोर करती नजर आती है।

NOTA(None of the Above) व्यवस्था लागू करना एक महत्त्वपूर्ण सुधार माना जाता है, चुनाव आयोग द्वारा द्विव्यांगो, दुर-दराज के मतदाताओं के लिए मतदान वेंद्र तक पहुँच सुनिश्चित करने के लिए लगातार प्रयास किए जाते हैं। राजनितिक वर्ग और चुनावों को अपराध से मुक्त करने के तरिके और साधन खोजने के लिए एक साथ आने की जरूरत है। अपराधियों के राजनिति में प्रवेश को और अधिक गंभिरता से लिया जाना चाहिए। साथ ही गठबंधन के मामलें में चुनावी सुधारों की भी दरकार है। भारतीय लोकतंत्र तब मजबूत होगा जब सभी राजनीतिक दल, मीडिया सहित सभी हितधारक अपनी जिम्मेदारी को गंभीरता से लेंगे और चुनावी व्यवस्था जैसी लोकतांत्रिक संस्थाओं को मजबूत करने में एक-दुसरे की मदद करेंगे।

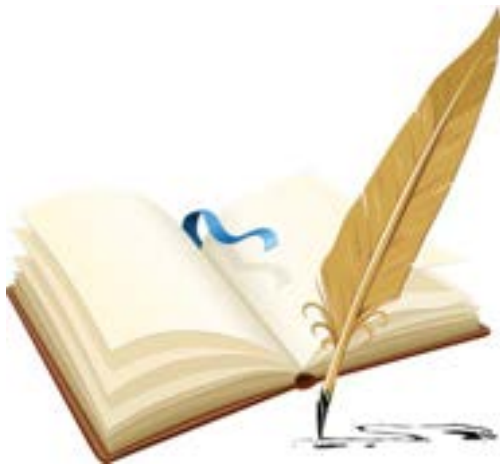

Department of Commerce and Accountancy

The Department offers B.Com and M.Com programmes to the students in and around Vasai, along with self-financed courses of B.Com in Accounting and Finance (BAF), Bachelor of Management Studies (BMS), B.Com in Banking and Insurance (BBI) and has a student strength of over 2000 students at the UG and PG level. The department maintained its beyond-the-classroom learning connection with students using the G Suite. Google classrooms were prepared by the faculties for the courses taught by them. The Whatsapp groups created class-wise, enabled the mentors to cater to the needs of the mentees anytime and even beyond college working hours. Students of the department were also encouraged to join online courses of SWAYAM to make them industry-prepared.

Results – June 2022

The department results are a reflection of the continuous efforts taken by the teaching faculty to uphold the vision and mission statement of the college “Let thy Light Shine”

T.Y.B. Com results were 93.54% - 542 students appeared and 507 were successful in the exams. 17 students secured A+ grade. TYBAF results were 100% - 116 students appeared and were successful in the exams with 1 student getting an O grade and 29 A+ grades.

TYBBI results were 100% - 49 students appeared all have been successful in the exams. 15 students secured an A+ grade.

TYBMS results were 100% - 132 students appeared and all have cleared the exams. 26 students secured A+ grades.

M.Com (Management) results were 85% - 20 students appeared and 17 were successful in the exams with 9 students securing A+ grades.



M.Com (Advanced Accountancy) results were 72 % - 55 students appeared and 40 students were successful in the exams with 11 students securing A+ grade.

2. During the current year, the Women Development Cell (WDC) undertook a comprehensive Gender Audit for the period spanning from 2019 to 2022. The purpose of conducting this gender audit was to evaluate and scrutinize the integration of gender equality within the organization. This evaluation encompassed an assessment of gender-related policies, programs, projects, provision of services, and other proceedings. The underlying principle behind conducting a gender audit in an educational institution is to recognize that public policies can have distinct impacts on female and male learners. By conducting this audit, the WDC aimed to identify areas of improvement and ensure a more inclusive and equitable environment for all individuals within the institution.

3. On March 16th, 2023, the Women Development Cell collaborated with the Wings Foundation to conduct an awareness and guidance program focused on "Menstrual Waste Management and Hygiene." The objective of this program was to create awareness among participants about proper menstrual waste disposal practices and promote menstrual hygiene. Through this initiative, the organizers aimed to empower individuals with knowledge and guidance to ensure safe and environmentally friendly management of menstrual waste while also emphasizing the importance of maintaining good menstrual hygiene practices.

The total collection of the college library stands at 48,895+. This year the library has performed various activities such as a book exhibition and National Online Workshop, Readers Club Activities and more. Library activities for the academic year 2022-23 are as follows:

1. Library Literacy Orientation Programme: Librarian delivered a lecture to first-year students of different classes to create awareness of library services and increase the reading habits among students. The librarian also informed about the N-LIST (National Library and Information Services Infrastructure of Scholarly Content), DELNET, Online Swayam Courses and library online service.

2. Library: Readers Club Activity

The published article was read and discussed during the session. The principal and Vice-Principal were invited to the session.
